Main Teaching - Who Am I?

Each morning we meet together for the main teaching session. During this time we sing, interview leaders, plug books and Christian social media, and, most importantly, open up God's word.

The teaching will focus on our identity in Christ. We aim to show how true (and everlasting) identity is found in Christ alone, and consider the impact of this as we relate it to current cultural issues.

Our hope through the camp teaching is to provide a solid grounding in Christ, seeing in Paul's letter to the Ephesians the implications of our new humanity in Jesus, and how the church is both a counter-cultural spiritual body, and a genuine force for Christ-centred change.

Outdoor Activities and Games

Our afternoons are spent enjoying various activities. The adventure sports are led by Christian instructors from Climb365, run by Stuart Carter, and Rock UK. This year we will be diving into pools in Langdale ghylls, learning to paddleboard on Lake Windermere and scaling Cumbrian cliffs.

Throughout the week we also organise a lot of fun games and activities. These are relaxed, although, with tent prizes up for grabs, they can get quite competitive. The games are based around a theme, which this year is

Spy and Detective

Continuing the theme of identity each day we'll be donning disguises, digging out our fake passports, playing games and undergoing challenges, with a Spy and Detective theme. Tents will accumulate points for our tents and hope to win the coveted Tent of the Year prize.

Tent Prayers - Unity, Diversity, Identity and Conformity

Our evenings end with a Bible study in tent groups of 4-6 similarly aged campers, each led by a tent leader and assistant.

Tent Prayers will follow on from the morning studies in Ephesians looking at various related cultural and social issues, drawing on a wider range of Scripture.

Tent Prayers are an opportunity for discussion and sharing. This builds relationships, between the campers themselves and with their tent leaders, which can last a lifetime. The time spent can change their lives forever through a relationship with the living God.
